Being allowed to drop children off half an hour earlier in the morning would be a very welcomed facility and I'm sure parents would be happy to pay to help fund a member of staff.
<u>Suggestions for improvements</u>
Having a better system in place for the nursery car park as it is horrendous - a member of staff directing traffic and encouraging staff and parents to park properly instead of just parking in the front spaces and abandoning their cars.
Stay and play groups to be available during the school holidays, using the Children's Centre? Or perhaps a Saturday group for children with additional needs, as happens in Bromsgrove.
More consistent homework!
Please can we have better notice for events, i.e. coffee mornings, assemblies, not everyone has a computer and it's difficult at short notice to arrange time off.
Text messages to parents
Confusion over some dates on letters
Please can parking / pick up and collection be looked at outside the nursery at the end of school. Regularly frustrating being blocked in the car park for up to 15 minutes at a time / borderline dangerous for the children crossing it. Know space is at a premium but any new approach would be appreciated.
Can't think of any at the moment.
We feel no improvements need to be made.
I'm really happy with everything and can not think of any improvements.

More use of the texting system to communicate with parents
More consistency with homework/reading in school daily
More meetings with parents whose children go on transport (to aide communication). Parents to be invited into school when they start a new class (September) to meet other children/parents/teachers/ta's, maybe for just an hour?
Monthly newsletter providing information about upcoming events and any successes pupils have achieved.
School nurse - will she be attending clinic appointments still? Is the dentist service still happening? Did try emailing her a few months ago but have not had a response.
